DEVOTION

Psalm 1:1,2

Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful;

But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and in His law he meditates day and night.


BEING BLESSED BY GOD: PSALM 1

This first Psalm contrasts the life of a godly person who is blessed by God, and a person who is neither godly nor blessed.

Blessed is a Hebrew superlative which means to have joy many times over, a sense of overflowing joy. Many of us seek happiness, which relies on an event, but joy comes from a disposition of life.

A blessed person is mindful of the following:

- **1. Don't go to the world for counsel.** Verse 1 says, "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the un-godly." Sadly, many Christians go to the world first rather than to a godly pastor, elder or confident to be counselled from the Word of God.
- **2. Temptation is a process.** Psalm 1 presents the idea of walking, then standing in the path of sinners, and finally sitting in the seat of the scornful. Often, temptation starts with listening to the counsel of the un-godly, and it's not very long before we are standing, contemplating the temptation and if we do that, without getting it right with God, then very quickly we find ourselves sitting in the seat of the scornful. So, if we want to be people who are marked by joy then we need to not be governed by the things of the world such as the world's entertainment, the types of books or magazines that are ungodly and so on.
