What does 2011 hold for Challenge?

Uganda: we have a wonderful opportunity to commence printing a new edition for Uganda and also print the Kenyan edition in Uganda on state of the art equipment meaning a better quality paper can be produced.

Nigeria: Ireland Outreach International, the organization that we plan to partner with has 1000 centres that they have established and are working through distributing the Emmaus Bible course. They would like 1000 papers for each centre making a total of one million papers bi-monthly.

India and South America both present amazing opportunities to the gospel. Carl will be visiting both during the course of the year to ensure the smooth running of the operation and seeking sponsorship for the paper from local churches and businesses.

Zimbabwe has seen an amazing response to the paper and they are requesting an increase from 30,000 to 50,000 papers bi-monthly

The possibility has arisen to produce a new edition for Greece and five new countries in South America. We still have standing requests for Egypt, Liberia, Malaysia and the Philippines for their own edition of the paper.

PRAISE POINTS

1. In 2010 nearly four million Challenge papers were distributed globally and the response to the paper continues to astound us. Many people are now being discipled and some have received their own Bible.

HELP IS NEEDED

Challenge requires volunteers who are willing and able to come to the office in Perth half a day a month to wrap the paper for distribution within Australia. It is a great time of fellowship as well as work, there is no heavy lifting required and no skills are needed except to work as part of a team. PRAYER POINTS

Challenge desperately requires an Editor/journalist to oversee the production of 12 different editions of the paper. This will free up Carl Carmody to carry out his many other responsibilities.

Finances are at a critical point, with the need to finance the running of the Australian office and also for the global printing and distribution of the paper. Challenge need to raise an additional \$10,000 per month to continue this work and we are seeking the support of 1000 individuals who will commit to \$10 per month or more if they are in a position to do so. We thank you for prayerfully considering this before the Lord. Please note: this does not include future projects, but to be able to maintain the current ones.

Australian distribution: our prayer is to see the paper distribution increase to 75,000 each month and that churches and individuals would see the opportunities the paper presents to share the Gospel.

Easter edition: Please pray specifically for the testimonies and articles that they will speak into the lives of all who read them. Also for churches to use this wonderful opportunity to sow seed into their local community.

For the writers who regularly contribute articles to the paper.

Impact Africa, as this year Challenge is planning to run two trips to South Africa, in July and November. Pray for those going that the Lord may use and grow them and for the ministries that will be happening, and that people will respond in faith to Him rather than out of guilt or obligation.

Things are tight at home with the running of the office and with the need of equipment to produce all the different editions. The global work is also an issue with the need of funding for the South African Prison edition, Uganda, Zambia and many other countries in Africa as well as the work in India and South America.
