Put off ... put on

1 Thessalonians 5:7-8

"For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk are drunk at night. But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation."

- A. Put off before we can put something on we need to first take off what we have on. We must first put off the desires of the flesh, as this is an opening for our spiritual enemies. They draw many, and keep them, by making them drunk - drunk with pride, drunk with passion, drunk with self-conceit, drunk with success.
 - B. Put on The breastplate of Faith and Love The helmet of Hope

We need to arm ourselves against our flesh and its attempts to draw us into sin, by putting on the spiritual breast-plate to protect the heart, and the spiritual helmet to secure the head; this spiritual armour consists of three great graces of Christians, faith, love, and hope.

- 1. We must live by faith, and this will keep us watchful and sober
- 2. We must have a heart of love (God's Love); and this will also be our defence against issues of pride.
- 3. We must make salvation our hope. Our hopes are to be grounded upon God's promises and completed work: because God has not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation, and that salvation is secured by our Lord

Jesus Christ, who died for us.

COUNTRY IN FOCUS

SOUTH AFRICA – IMPACT AFRICA MISSION TRIP

South Africa: continues to be very fertile ground for the gospel and the Challenge paper continues to be a vital part of the ministry there.

Prisons: the work in the prisons continues to be very fruitful with many testifying that they have read of others prisoners who have found forgiveness in Jesus Christ then maybe they also could know this forgiveness and relationship with God. We will be distributing the prison edition of the paper and following up enquiries made. June saw our first edition of the paper being distributed in Zimbabwean prisons and we look forward to the response.

VBS: The increase in attendance caught us out last year. We prepared meals for 400 and had approx 500 attending. This is a wonderful blessing in being able to share the gospel with so many, but it also causes issues on our ability to supply the extra meals required. This year the VBS will be held in a new location and we look forward expectantly at what the Lord is going to do. Again the children will be taught Creation to Christ over 5 days and on the final day an opportunity to respond will be given, both for children and attending parents,

Partners: Part of the purpose of the trip is to help strengthen the arm of our partners both financially and practically, being extra hands and feet to serve where needed most.

- Impact Africa Mission Team in South Africa: The team will be 30 people of which there will be 22 from Australia. Please pray for team safety, unity for the team, health, opportunities to share, the words to speak.
- Project funding: We are looking to raise \$40,000 this year to cover costs and this continues to be an ongoing issue as funds are needed to cover the cost of providing food for the VBS and squatters camps, CLI training for local pastors, Bibles, 70,000 newspapers to be distributed and other projects.
- For leaders: to be able to deal with situations as they arise
- Team unity: that the team may have one heart and one vision.
- Print funding: the need is \$25,000 to meet current commitments and then ongoing funding to continue the work in South Africa, South America and India
