## PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for the smooth transition of the Trezona family to the US as there is much to be done before they move.
- Pray for our financial needs here in Australia: specifically personal support of staff to cover salaries; and for general gifts for the running of the work.
- For distribution growth of Challenge paper in Australia. We have been praying for the distribution to get to 75,000 papers per month but have remained at 45,000-50,000. Pray for orders from a recent promotion visit to South Australia.
- Pray for extra orders to come through for our Christmas / New Year edition of the paper as many churches use this edition for strategic outreach during the festive season. Last year almost 100,000 papers went which is a lot of seed sown.
- Pray for the need of replacement staff. Charissa Mitting will leave us in January 2012 and we are looking to replace her with an Editor Journalist. Also with Andrew Trezona and his family moving to the US in February we are looking for a replacement for him for promotion and development work of the paper in Australia
- Pray for our writers who do a great job for the paper around the world. Pray for inspiration for them as they write on a variety of subject matter relating to the non-Christian.
- Pray for our work in India which has been struggling of late. We are looking to have a change of Director and to tighten up the budget so that we can be consistent in getting out the paper as well as fund promotion of it. We are also looking to do some four page language inserts in Hindi and Tamil in the near future.

## PRAISE POINTS

- Praise God for the recent trip of Andrew and Karen Trezona to the US in preparation for their move as a family there in February 2012 to build on the work already established
- Praise God for the response to the Ugandan Edition of the paper. The paper is also used in prisons there and some Southern Baptist Missionaries have been asked to run a Bible Study for the prison guards which is amazing.
- Praise God for the churches visited recently in the US and for the response to the paper with some encouraging orders.
- Praise God for the recent visit Carl Carmody made to South Australia where through the efforts of our representative there in Alan Bailey we visited some 35 churches.
- Praise the Lord that we have had two churches commit to supporting the work in India, while we have not reached our budget figure we are rejoicing in the Lord's provision.
- Praise God for the wonderful team of volunteers that help in the wrapping of the Challenge newspaper and our children's publication called Explorer's Magazine for postage.
