


PRAYER LETTER OF CHALLENGE LITERATURE **FELLOWSHIP**

A fascinating incident in the history of Israel is recorded in 2 Kings 6-7.

The king of Aram "mobilized his entire army and marched up and laid siege to Samaria. " As a consequence, "There was a great famine in the city; the siege lasted so long that a donkey's head sold for eighty shekels of silver". Hunger began to torment the inhabitants of the city. Things got so bad that women even cooked and ate their own children!

Four lepers who lived by the city gate finally decided to cast themselves on the mercy of the enemy army.

"If we stay here, we will die," they reasoned. "So let's go over to the camp of the Arameans and surrender. If they spare us, we live: if they kill us, then we die. "

As night came on, the lepers set off for the Aramean camp. "When they reached the edge of the camp, not a man was there, for the Lord had caused the Arameans to hear the sound of chariots and horses and a great army, so that they said to one another: 'Look, the king of Israel has hired the Hittite and Eavptian kings to attack us!' So they got up and fled in the dusk and abandoned their tents and their horses and donkeys. They left the camp as it was and ran for their lives."

The lepers found the camp completely deserted.
