Here are some ideas to get you started as you think about ways to share your faith this festive season...

- 1. Share a meal: Plan to have people you have been meaning to share your faith with for a while over for a meal. Be intentional about bringing up matters of faith.
- **2. Make an invitation list:** Make a list of people you can invite to your church's Christmas service and make sure you give them plenty of notice so they can arrange their plans accordingly.
- 3. Mentally prepare to share: Be prepared to bring up church, the true meaning of Christmas and matters of faith when colleagues and people you encounter daily ask you what you have planned for Christmas. Make your conversations count.
- **4. Help out:** Many people will be working in their gardens, fixing things around the house etc. What a perfect time to be intentional about helping your friends and neighbours out. There will
